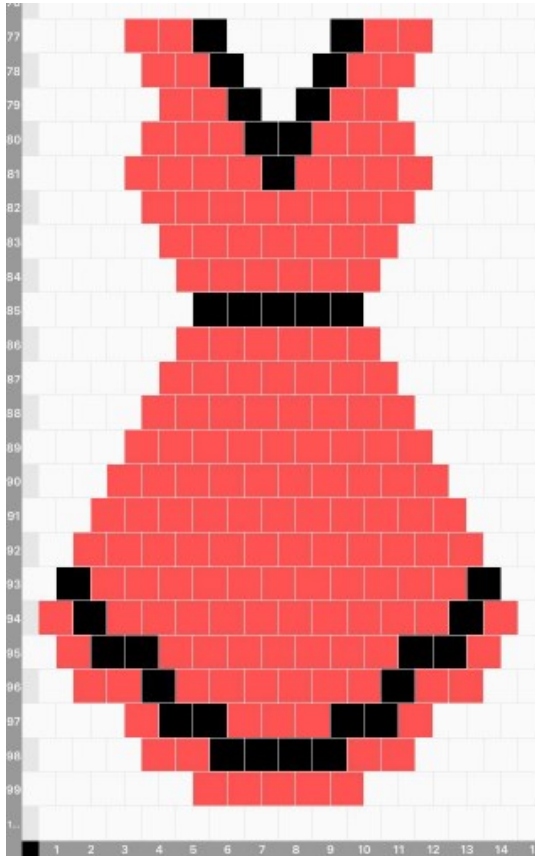


# Lil' Red Dress Project—Basic Pin

## Mandatory Supplies

- Red size 11/0 Delica beads by Miyuki—any shade, finish
- Size 11/0 Miyuki Delicas in a different colour
- Fireline thread (fishing line) 6lb capacity
- Size 11 beading needle
- Scissors

## Optional Supplies

- Bar pin backings—0.75 inch
- E6000 glue
- Clear nail polish

## Zig-Zag start to brickstitch

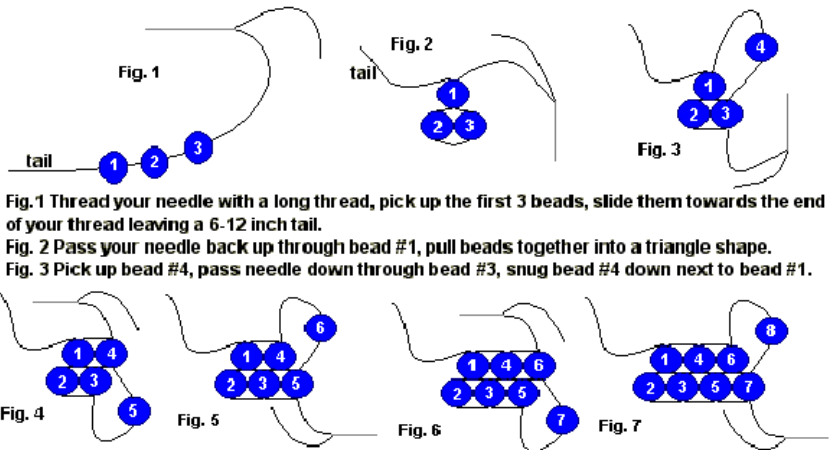


Fig. 1 Thread your needle with a long thread, pick up the first 3 beads, slide them towards the end of your thread leaving a 6-12 inch tail.

Fig. 2 Pass your needle back up through bead #1, pull beads together into a triangle shape.

Fig. 3 Pick up bead #4, pass needle down through bead #3, snug bead #4 down next to bead #1.

You can follow along with our YouTube video to learn how to make your pin. Once the beading is complete, a thin coat of nail polish is applied to one side of the pin. Bar pins are attached via E600 after the polish is dry.

\*\* We do ask that the pattern is not used for personal profit, but proceeds go back towards the Lil' Red Dress Project. Alternatively, proceeds can go to a different MMIWG project with credit to the Lil' Red Dress Project.
